- With our mission, vision, and value statements complete, we now must decide upon our goals for the newest strategic plan. Theresa offers that we may want to be succinct and limit our strategic goals to 8 to 10 points in creating LIS' blueprint for the next few years.
- Of our ten strategic goals from the 2003-2008 Strategic Plan, we have continued with #10, providing funding for consortial memberships and initiatives, by keeping our memberships up-to-date and part of #4, hiring an additional public services librarian, with the creation of the Serials Librarian and Music Librarian positions.

- Xudong would also like to make the addition of #1 from the 2003-2008 plan, enhance resources (\$100,000 annually includes a 10% increase for periodicals).
- Since many of Xudong's items fall under the operating budget rather than strategic plan, he will revise and send it out again to the group before we vote.
